


May 15-16 – Novara-Alessandria – **AI e Humanities - Progetto Gianni 2024 - Arte digitale e didattica immersivo-inclusiva** – As part of the research program "LET-in-Law: Legal Education and Training in Law", the University of Piemonte Orientale hosted a series of highly engaging meetings and experiences on legal education, exploring the intersection of multimedia and affectivity.

September 7-12 – Seoul, South Korea – **Aesthetics of Law as a branch of Philosophy of Law** – The Italian Society for Law and Literature supported a SW that will be held in Seoul, during the IVR World Congress 2024, directed by K. Zeidler, T. Kawase, and P. Chmielowska.

October 04 – Urbino – **Lo strano caso dell'imputato Josef K** – In collaboration with ISLL, the chair of Criminal Procedure Law at the Department of Law of the University of Urbino has launched a series of meetings on Criminal Procedure and Literature.

December 08 – Ancona – Created as an educational experiment for the Summer School in Law and Humanities directed by Paolo Heritier in Cannes, and involving the participation of students, **Dans la grotte** by Gianluca Abbate and Angelo Cretella won the Dorico Virtual Award for Best Short Film 2024.


